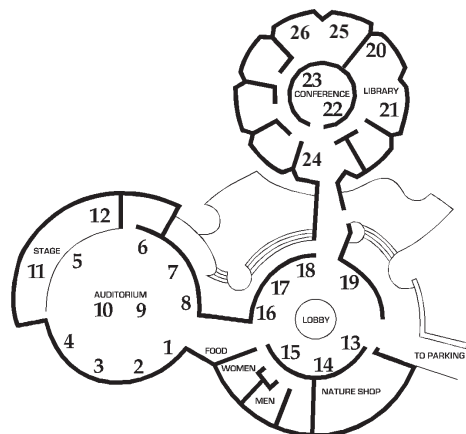

Exhibit Set-Up

ALL applicants must be available to set up their displays on *Friday, November 19 between 10 am and 7 pm*. Also, all artists must park their vehicles on the street during the show so customers can park in the parking lot. The show is Saturday, November 20 from 9–5 and Sunday, November 21 from 11 am–5 pm. Artists can enter the building one hour before the show opens.
